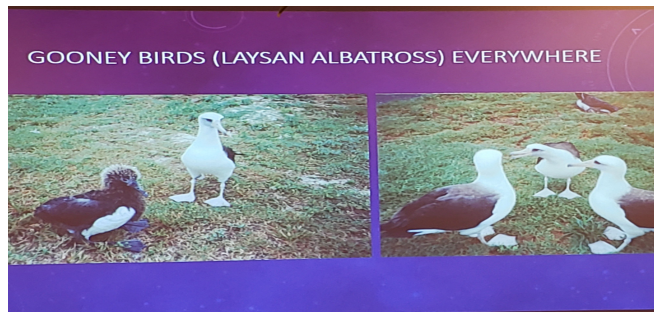

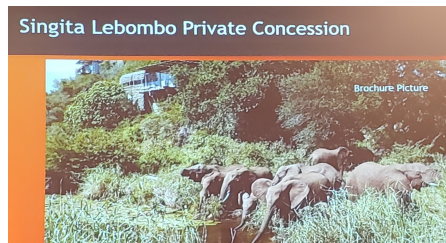
March Meeting: The monthly meeting was held at Sizzler's restaurant Monday March 2, 2020. The presenter was Pete Ziliox, K5PZ.



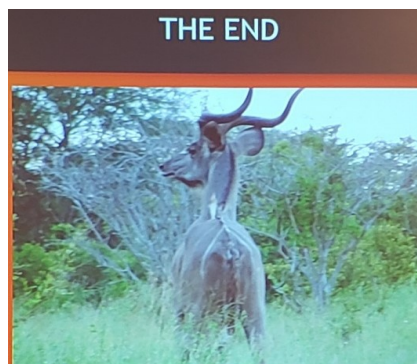
He presented a review of his expedition to Midway Island which included images of wild life there:
